

To be a **Math Marlin**, a student must:



1. Complete 3 math fact sheets for each of the grade level requirements.
2. Each math fact sheet must be completed with 100% accuracy.
3. Each math fact sheet should be completed in four minutes.
5. The deadline for being a Math Marlin is **May 25th, 2018**.
6. Teachers submit names of Math Marlins upon achievement for Treasure Chest prize and certificate
7. Principal's All-Stars to be submitted at the end of each quarter.

To earn the **Principal's All Star Award**, students must meet the grade level Math Marlin requirements and successfully complete the extra math fact requirements noted under the Principal's Math All Star Award column. Students who earn the Principal's All Star Award will earn pizza with the Principal at the end of the quarter. The award is earned *once* per student per school year.
