Mandatory Dress Rehearsal

Grades 4-6th: Wednesday, June 6, 2:00 to approximately 4:00 in MPR.

We will rehearse in performance order. Please clear your schedule. No changes in schedule allowed. Once your child has finished their run through, they will be excused. Due to the large amount of students auditioning, students must be present and ready with all of their required audition items at their selected time.

Auditions will be held in the LMC. Auditions are closed to performers only. All students who meet the requirements for the talent show at the time of their audition will be in the show. **Any student not meeting the requirements for the talent show at the time of their audition will NOT be in the talent show.** Due to the large number of participants and audience members, the 2018 Talent Show will be broadcast live into classrooms for grades K-3. Grades 4-6 will attend in the MPR.

REQUIREMENTS:

Prior to Audition: **(NO EXCEPTIONS)**

1. Turn in your completed TALENT SHOW APPLICATION to the Fugman Office by May 21st @ 4:30 PM. (available on website)
2. Attach printed lyrics to any song you will be singing or any song you will be using to your application by May 21st @ 4:30 PM. (For example: if you're dancing to a piece of music with words on the recording, we need a PRINTED copy of the words, REGARDLESS of whether or not the words are played during the performance.) ORIGINAL version of the lyrics must be appropriate for a K-6 audience.

At the time of the audition, you must:

1. Wear any costume you will be wearing during your performance. All participants must be current Fugman students, and in Fugman and CUSD Dress Code. If you do not have your outfit at the time of your audition, you will have to perform in your regular school clothes during the talent show.
2. Have your act memorized and rehearsed. Incomplete or unrehearsed acts will not be put in the show. We need you to **show** us your act-not **tell** us what you'll be doing. (Note: Those playing a musical instrument may use music.)
3. Make sure your act is **NO LONGER** than 2 MINUTES, and **no more than one musical piece**. You will be timed at your audition.
4. Have an accompaniment track if you are singing with a CD. This means there can be **NO OTHER VOICES** on the music that you will be singing with at the show. Otherwise, you will have to sing acapella (without recorded music.)

****Each student may ONLY be in ONE act.**

****No acts with dangerous props or anything that will fall to the stage or make any kind of mess will be allowed.**

****No lip syncing acts allowed.**

****If two or more people prepare the same vocal pieces, they will have the chance to choose another song to sing for the show or sing a duet, trio, etc. as well as those who have chosen the same song to dance to.**

**** Any students violating these rules during the Talent Show will be cut off in middle of their act AND eliminated from participating in following school years at Fugman.**
