In recent years, it has become increasingly familiar to and celebrated by individuals outside of Mexican heritage. The holiday is a celebration remembering departed loved ones such as friends and family members. The celebration takes place on October 31st, November 1st, and November 2nd. Traditions

include building private altars in homes, giving offerings of sugar skulls and marigolds, and visiting grave sites with these as gifts and the favorite foods and beverages of the departed.
