School Safety

Keeping a school safe cannot be the job of one person, but rather all of us working together to follow and ensure rules set in place for safety are being observed. We can all be proactive in maintaining a safe school environment. We are asking that parents please do the following:

Sign in at the front office and get your sticker prior to going to your child's classroom regardless of how quick the visit will be. This is the expectation and is set forth in our Safety Plan submitted to the district and state. All visitors will be sent back to the office for this important step if we do not see a visible sticker. This helps us be diligent in noticing if there is someone on campus that should not be.

Please remain out of the hallways before school and after school. We have a large student population and just getting our students to their classrooms in an efficient and safe way is tough. Extra adults means the focus of our teacher's now becomes on determining who the adults are and if they are signed in. We ask the same for dismissal time. If you have a parent conference with your child's teacher before or after school, please check in at the office.

Please do not attempt to enter the C building by knocking on doors until someone answers. Our students are trained not to open locked doors to anyone, even staff. Always check in first.

Alert the office or staff members if you see something suspicious or if something on our grounds seems unsafe.

Please remember that our staff will be holding to these policies as it is these policies that keep our students safe. You may be stopped by staff and asked if you have signed in or where you are headed.

As stated earlier, school safety is everyone's concern and each of us play a vital role in keeping our school safe. We thank you in advance for following our procedures and appreciate your partnership in maintaining a safe school environment.

Fugman is a very busy campus and each of our classrooms are at or near capacity. We appreciate our parents' help to minimize classroom interruptions. Here is how you can help:

- Campus opens at 8:00 am. Please be sure your child is not on campus unsupervised before that time.
- School is out at 3:15 M/T/TH/F and 1:45 on Wednesdays. Sports practice ends at 4:20. Thank you for making arrangements for a timely pick up from school.

CUSD Dress Code Reminders

The Clovis Unified School District Governing Board states the following related to the CUSD dress code:

We believe that attention to appearance and a student's attitude toward self and school are related. Good taste, good grooming, and appropriateness of attire are a part of learning for all students. However, we recognize that students' mode of dress and grooming is a manifestation of their personal style and individual preference. We believe that students and parents can freely choose apparel that demonstrates individuality, as well as maintain the standards of appropriateness.

These regulations specify standards of dress and grooming promoting a safe school setting conducive to a positive learning environment consistent with the Board's policy governing acceptable and appropriate apparel and appearance for students.

Please refer to <http://www.cusd.com/dress-code/> for a reminder of the full dress code. Here are 3 reminders we would like to share with our community:

- Leggings will be allowed if over-garment is no shorter than five inches (5") above the top of the kneecap, but no shorter than mid-thigh.
- No frayed or torn clothing is unacceptable (manufactured or otherwise).
- Hair or mustache styles which cause undue attention are not acceptable; e.g., unusual designs, colors, symbols, messages, mohawks, Faux-Hawks, or unusual razor cuts. Complete razor shaving of the head is allowed.
