- Campus opens at 8:00 am. Please be sure your child is not on campus unsupervised before that time.
- School is out at 3:15 M/T/TH/F and 1:45 on Wednesdays. Sports practice ends at 4:20. Thank you for making arrangements for a timely pick up from school.
- Please plan appointments outside of school hours, if possible.
- Please communicate with your child's teacher if you are checking your child out early.
- If you are checking your child out early from school, please call 15 mins before you arrive to ensure your child is ready.
- Please have a lunch plan in place before you drop your child off for the day. Cold lunches can be left on the back cabinet by the Nurse's Office. We no longer leave lunches on the front table.
- Many of our students have food allergies so we ask parents to remind their children not to share any food at school. If you leave a pizza (an example) for your child please be aware that only your child can eat the pizza.
- Our parking lots are very busy. We ask that all parents use caution and patience while picking up or dropping off your child. If you plan on exiting your vehicle, please park in a parking space.
